The Gdynia Aquarium is part of the National Marine Fisheries Research Institute whose roots go back to the twenties of the last century.

The Aquarium modernistic building, situated in a place where the city meets the sea, conceals more than 130 tons of water where almost 2 thousand aquatic and amphibian animals live. One can meet here the inhabitants of the colourful coral reef, the open ocean waters, the eternally green Amazon jungle as well as the dwellers of the Baltic Sea. Thanks to a dazzling variety of species, it is possible to meet the world's heaviest snake - the anaconda, the most intelligent Earth's invertebrate - the octopus and to touch (!) fish from our sea in only one visit to the Aquarium.

The NMFRI Gdynia Aquarium, which is a highly popular tourist attraction in the region, besides regular expositions, offers numerous special events which are a fixed point in the Tricity calendar.
